I have an old doll that the paint is coming off around the neck and the top of the head where the wig was. The paint seems to be very dull looking compared to my other antique dolls. Do you think this is a ceramic head? She's suppose to be an Eaton Beauty. Shirley.

Dear Shirley

What you have is called a painted bisque. It is still porcelain, but the paint is applied and allowed to dry and then a sealer is sprayed on. It is not refired in the kiln. Your other dolls are china painted and kiln fired. Eatons put out painted bisque between 1934-1939, usually on a 5 piece body. Dolly

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Job description of the President of MDC

She shall chair all general meetings of the club and at all meetings of the executive committee.
